The wonderful world of horror cinema offers many delights to those who like their ocular entertainment both violent and bloody, but look beyond the obvious trappings of the genre and you will see many things that are much more pleasing to the eye. One such example of the horrific meeting the sublimely beautiful is talented, upcoming actress Suzi Lorraine. This blonde bombshell has the kind of screen presence that you are unlikely to forget and, having caught some of her earlier work, I felt that an interview would be a great way for you guys to find out what makes our Suzi tick.

TFA - Hi Suzi, thanks very much for taking time out of your busy shooting schedule to have a chat with The Film Asylum. First off, could you tell us know how you got involved with the upcoming horror movie "**The Night They Returned**" and was it fun playing the character Tawny Taggart?

SL - I had worked on a movie called "**Cold Blonded Murder**" with SVBI Films in Montreal last year. We all had so much fun working on it, and, much to my delight, I was contacted by SVBI Films again when they began production on "**The Night They Returned**". It was an absolute blast playing Tawny Taggart – my character was so wild and over the top – I ate it right up. (Quite literally, too – she is a cannibal). Everything was no holds barred – crazy scenes, tons of blood and guts and gore, great special effects, monsters, sexy cannibal sisters, genuinely funny scenes, and a strong plot that really grabs you & holds your attention throughout the whole wacky ride.

TFA - Is the horror genre one which sits well with the type of roles you relish playing or is your overall game plan one that sees genre movies as a platform to more mainstream cinema?

SL - Actually I was drawn to the industry simply for the fact that I love horror movies! I'm a horror junkie. Ever since I was young, it's always been my favorite genre. All kinds – from intellectual, psychological thrillers, to slasher films – I've always been attracted to that kind of stuff – the underbelly of society, the darker side of humanity, what makes crazy people tick... It's fascinating.

TFA - You have been known to use one or two pseudonyms depending on the type of role your undertaking. Don't you think that this causes a little confusion amongst the casual viewer?

SL - Nah! Keeps 'em on their toes. I'm thinking of changing my stage to Sheba, or maybe Bubba.

TFA - What would you consider to be your big-break in your movie career and how did it come about?

SL - Probably landing the lead role in "**Cold Blonded Murder**" – it was one of the first parts I felt I could really sink my teeth into, gave me a lot to work with, and that showcased my acting abilities.

TFA - if you could star in a big budget remake of any movie, which one would you choose and what role would you play?

SL - I'd love to star in a remake of "**Psycho**" (even though it was already re-made)and play Marion Crane.

TFA - You list gardening as something you like to do in your spare time. Do you grow your own carrots or do you prefer a nice bunch of Pansy's?

SL - I prefer herbs of the "natural" variety, haha.

TFA - Are you planning on making any personal appearances in the near future at any film conventions or festivals perhaps?

SL - I'd like to. Maybe at Chiller Theatre in April – I would love to have my own table for the Chiller convention this October. We'll see....

TFA - Just a few of your favourite things.....

TFA - What's next for the gorgeous Suzi? Any other projects you would like to reveal to your fans?

SL - I'm going into production on "**The Day of The Ax**" with 4th Floor Pictures in May. I recently completed a small role in "**Thorn**" with Dyers Eve Films, which will premiere later this month at The Broadway Theater in NJ. "**The Night They Returned**" with SVBI Films will be released later this month, and will most likely be shown at the Fantasia Film Festival in Montreal. I played the host in "**Around Midnight**" with Falcon Video, with a release date sometime next month. I also had a starring role this summer in "**Acrimony**" with Saint Sinner Entertainment – it will be released on video later this year.

TFA - Finally, if a race of aliens abducted you in order to dabble in a little mind probing, what would they discover that would frighten the slime out of them?

SL - Just the fact that one little girl can have so many different personalities, all wrapped into one.
