what you get to do as an actor.

Jhon: What makes a great lead actress in a horror film? And a lot of actors turn into directors or producers.

down numerous
roles because I
did not dig the
dialog for
whatever reason.
I just can't pour
myself into a role
if I don't believe in
the project. On

the other hand, once I sign onto a project, I will give 110% every time. I am very passionate about it.

Jhon: Other than remembering lines, any funny bloopers or stories or mishaps of body function of zombies included lol, you can share with us?

Suzi: Well in pretty much every film I've ever done, I always fall down on film at some point. You can see it in "Countdown to Extinction". There's this big riot scene, and I'm running thru the crowd and I trip and almost hit the deck.

Jhon: What was the fun nest film to work on and why?

Suzi: "The Night They Returned", because I played this twisted little character, and I got to improv some really funny scenes. And everybody in that cast was amazing to work with! Super cool people. It's coming out

notices you
have a lot of
diversity in
your roles in
the horror/
slasher
films. Tell
us about
playing the
victim and
playing the
person
pursuing your
victims. Like
in playing a
night
prowlserial
killer in
"Cold Blonded
Murder" SVBI
Films.

Suzi: Wow,
playing the
killer is
definitely
more fun and
more
rewarding to
me than
playing a
victim. As a
killer, you
can be as
mean and evil
and
aggressive
and crazy as
you want. And
let all your
emotions run
wild. It's an
adrenaline
rush.

Jhon: I was looking at the stills on your website on www.modelsuzi.com on the set of "The Night They Returned," Tells us about the props they used and is it fun pulling guts out of a Zombie, in a movie of course.

Suzi: We had a great special effects team working on that movie. I had to chew on all kinds of "body parts" made out of various substances. After the big cannibalism scene, my throat was sore for hours. Accidentally swallowed some of the guts! Haha.

Jhon: When you gave your first autograph, how did it feel? Was it strange?

Suzi: Oh yeah, it's bizarre, but it's extremely flattering.

Jhon: With clashes of Horror movie characters, Jason vs Freddy and Predator vs. Alien in the near future. What horror/ sci-fi clash you like to see and why?

Suzi: Candyman vs. the evil mutated little twin in Basket Case. Why? Because it would be funny.

Jhon: Who are some of the coolest actors/ actresses you had the pleasure to work with?
